Your recycling wheelie bin and glass recycling box will be emptied fortnightly on the days highlighted overleaf. Bank Holiday changes are also marked.

Please leave your recycling bin and box at the boundary of your property by 7am on the day of collection.

Please place the following in your grey bin for recycling:

- clean paper and newspapers
- magazines, pamphlets & junk mail
- cardboard (please squash boxes)
- food & drinks cans
- foil containers, foil milk bottle tops & cooking foil
- plastic bottles (please remove tops)

Please do not put the following in your grey bin:

- general household waste
- garden waste
- glass bottles (please use your black box or our bottle banks)
- other plastic containers (e.g. yoghurt, ice cream or margarine tubs)
- textiles (please use our textile banks)
- wood
- polystyrene
- food
- black sacks

Please place the following in your black box:

- jam jars
- coffee jars
- vinegar bottles
- sauce jars
- beer bottles
- wine bottles

We can collect all colours of glass bottles and jars. Currently only glass bottles and jars can be recycled, which are then turned back into new bottles. Other varieties of glass have different melting temperatures, which affects the production of new bottles.

Please do not put the following in your black box:

- broken glass
- mirrors, windows, windscreens
- drinking glasses
- pyrex
- painted bottles
- light bulbs & fluorescent tubes
- crockery

These items should either be taken to your local household tip or put in with your general household waste.

We are unable to collect recycling bins and boxes that contain the wrong materials.
